The Capital Projects Advisory Review Board's (CPARB) Project Review Committee (PRC) has determined that the City of Seattle has met the criteria established in RCW 39.10.270 for public body GC/CM and Design - Build certification.

As of January 3, 2008 the City of Seattle is authorized to utilize GC/CM and Design - Build contracting procedures for projects with a total project cost of ten million dollars or more for a period of three years.
